

The Land O' Lakes Fish & Game Club awards educational grants to educators in the Northland Pines and Phelps School Districts in Wisconsin and the Watersmeet School District in Michigan for curricular projects that meet the grant program objectives to enhance student awareness and appreciation of:

- Conservation of the Environment
- Human Impact on Natural Resources
- Forests, Lakes and Wildlife

The program is open to teachers, guidance counselors, and/or administrators of any subject and K-12 grade level.



Grants are commonly for projects less than \$500. However, highly innovative projects may be awarded up to \$1000.

WHY PARTICIPATE?

- Exposing youth to conservation concepts during their formative years contributes to public awareness of conservation issues and concerns
- Involving students in hands-on activities increases motivation to learn, provides opportunities for integration of subject areas and school curricular objectives
- Family awareness and media publicity on student projects help promote community understanding of the roles of teachers and schools in the community

ELIGIBLE PROJECTS

Successful proposals will meet the program objectives. PLUS, they will be those most likely to:

- Carry over to other interests and have enduring effects for the future
- Add to knowledge of the Northwoods through student-centered learning and cooperative research
- Generate increased awareness of the community at large

Examples of how projects meet grant program objectives include:

- Hands-on environmental education activities in the classroom and outdoors
- Student projects that involve observing, experimenting, mapping, critical and creative thinking, modeling, drawing
- Student research relating to natural history and/or the interaction of people with plants, wildlife, waterways, and resources in the Northwoods

Funds may be used for items not part of the regular school budget such as equipment, supplies, field trip expenses, or other activities that meet the objectives of the grant program.
